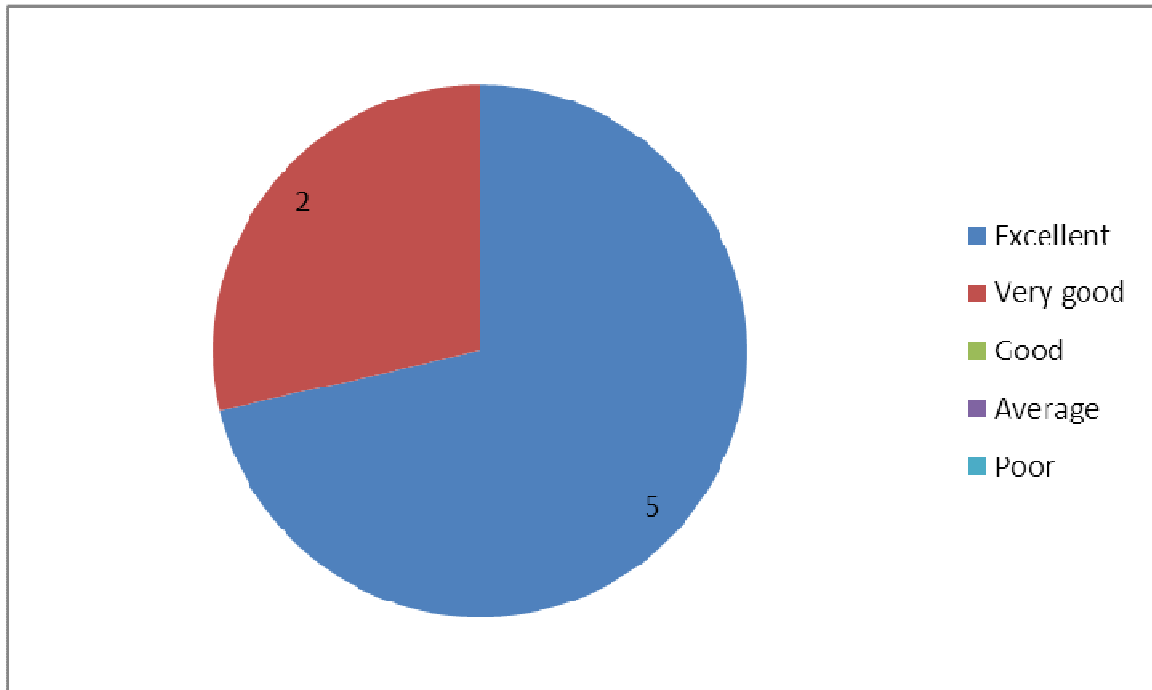


Mental Health Awareness Training Feedback analysis.

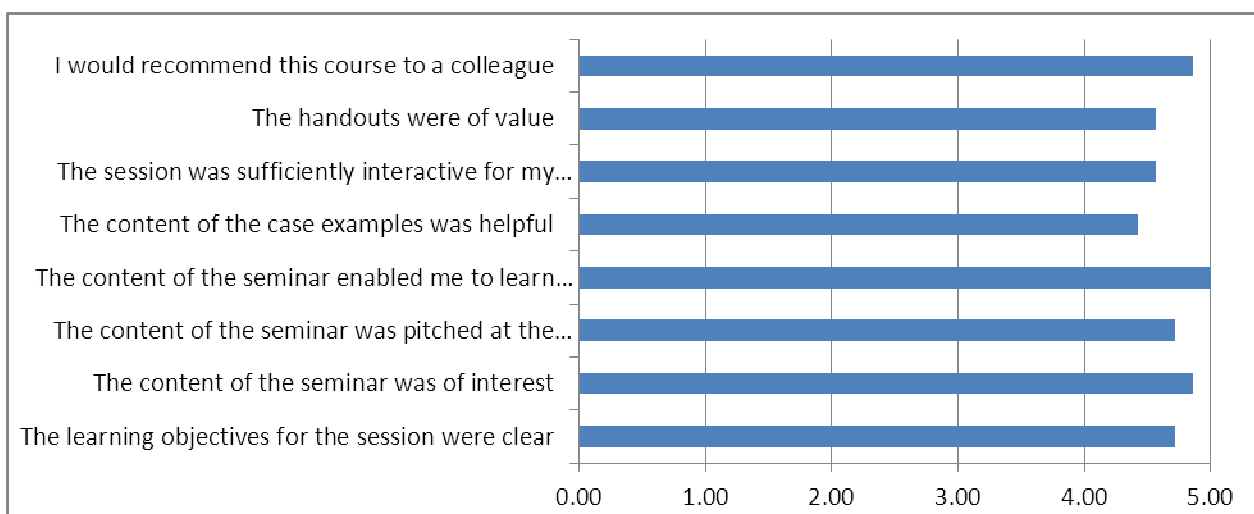
The following data is based on the feedback given by participants who attended the course.
